Nyandarua Water and Sanitation Company Limited, a private water utility company fully owned by the County Government of Nyandarua and with a mandate to provide water and sanitation services in Nyandarua County is seeking to recruit a self-driven individual for the position of a **Plumber**.

Job Purpose

To install, repair, and maintain water distribution systems, including pipelines, valves, meters, and fittings, ensuring continuous and safe water supply to customers in rural communities.

Key Responsibilities/ Duties /Tasks: -

- i. Install new water service connections for domestic and institutional customers.
- ii. Repair broken, leaking, or blocked water pipelines.
- iii. Maintain and replace valves, taps, meters, and fittings as required.
- iv. Assist in the construction of pipeline extensions and new water distribution lines.
- v. Perform routine inspection of pipelines and water installations to detect faults early.
- vi. Respond promptly to reported breakdowns, leakages, or bursts within the distribution network.
- vii. Record and report fieldwork completed, materials used, and any unresolved issues.
- viii. Ensure proper use and maintenance of plumbing tools, equipment, and safety gear.
- ix. Work closely with meter readers and customer care teams during investigations and maintenance visits.
- x. Provide basic customer education on proper use of water connections and fittings.
- xi. Support efforts to reduce non-revenue water (NRW) through prompt leak detection and repair.
- xii. Follow health and safety procedures while working in the field.
- xiii. Participate in emergency response operations such as fixing burst mains or supporting water trucking.
- xiv. Assist in the preparation of bills of quantities for plumbing works and material requisitions.
- xv. Maintain good relations with the community and represent the utility professionally on-site.

Job Requirements

- i. Certificate in Plumbing or Water Engineering.
- ii. Government Trade Test Certificate Grade I in Plumbing, Water Supply Technology, or a related field will be an added advantage.
- iii. A valid motorbike riding license (if required for fieldwork in dispersed rural areas) is an added advantage.
- iv. Practical skills in water plumbing installation, repair, and maintenance.
- v. Ability to read and interpret technical drawings and pipeline layouts.
- vi. Problem-solving ability in the field with limited supervision.
- vii. Good physical condition and **stamina for outdoor, manual work**.
- viii. Basic record-keeping and report writing.
- ix. Familiarity with safety standards and the use of protective equipment.
- x. Team player with a proactive and reliable work ethic.
- xi. Ability to work under pressure, especially during emergencies.
- xii. Basic understanding of rural water systems and community dynamics.
- xiii. Have good interpersonal relations and communication skills
- xiv. Excellent organization skills.
- xv. Successful Candidate must satisfy the requirements of chapter six of the constitution of Kenya on Leadership and integrity through provision of; -
 - a) Current certificate of good conduct from Directorate of Criminal Investigation Department.
 - b) Current Tax compliance certificate from Kenya Revenue Authority.
 - c) A clean and current report from an approved credit reference Bureau (CRB).
 - d) Clearance from the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC).
 - e) Clearance Certificate from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB).

The appointment will be for a fixed contract term of **3 YEARS** renewable subject to satisfactory performance evidenced by continuous achievement of performance targets.
